STEP 1 | If you have factory steps or sliders, they will need to be removed prior to install.

Use a 10mm socket to remove the factory nuts securing the slider to the body/pinch weld.

Then, while a friend supports the slider, remove the remaining factory hardware using a 13mm socket.

Remove the slider and set it off to the side. Repeat steps for opposite side of the vehicle.

Note: Assistance is recommended to prevent injury and damage to the product or vehicle.











Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from. Extra hardware may be included with the product.



STEP 2 | The size of the mounting holes on the vehicle can vary based on the year and trim.

With assistance, lift the steps to the vehicle and gently attempt to install them by pressing them into the mounting holes. Check that the holes are large enough to accept the studs on the steps.

If they are not large enough, drill them out as necessary. We recommend a 27/64" drill bit.









STEP 3 | With assistance, install the steps onto the vehicle and loosely thread on the provided M8 Nuts on center and rear mounts.

Use (1) M8 flat washer and (1) Split washer per M8 stud.

Note: Assistance is recommended to prevent injury and damage to the product or vehicle.



STEP 4 | Loosely Install the provided M8 bolts on all three mounts.

Only thread the bolts in to the first few threads.

Once all M8 bolts are loosely installed, press the steps up slightly so that the studs angled brackets sits flush against the pinch welds. Snug-up the M8 nuts using a 13mm socket and hand tools until the M6 studs fully protrude through the pinch weld.



STEP 5 | Thread the provided M6 nuts onto the M6 studs on the front mount. Use (1) M6 flat washer and (1) M6 split washer per M6 stud.

Once all hardware is loosely installed, secure the hardware on the studs using a 10mm and 13mm socket.







STEP 6 | Finish securing the remaining M8 bolts using a 13mm socket.

Repeat steps for the opposite side of the vehicle.

Double check fitment and all hardware is secure.
